Executive Summary:

At the May 16, 2011 City Council Meeting, Council approved an Ordinance change to remove the requirement that a rate 3 customer stay on rate 5 for 18 months after exceeding 25 kilowatt (KW) monthly demand. At that meeting we made a wording change to the second sentence to insert the words "current or" in front of "18 previous monthly billing periods." This item makes the same change to the first sentence of the ordinance which will add consistency and remove a point of potential confusion.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES - TITLE 13, "PUBLIC UTILITIES", CHAPTER 13.08, "ELECTRICITY" – SECTION 13.08.240, "RATE 3 – SMALL GENERAL SERVICE – RATES, CHARGES, AND SERVICE REQUIREMENTS", SUBSECTION A., "AVAILABILITY"

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: That Title 13 "Public Utilities", Chapter 13.08 "Electricity," Section 13.08.240 "Rate 3 – Small General Service – Rates, Charges and Service Requirements." Subsection A. "Availability", of the St. Charles Municipal Code be and is hereby amended by deleting the same and substituting the following:

"13.08.240 Rate 3 – Small General Service – Rates, Charges, and Service Requirements.
A. Availability.

Electrical energy is available under the Small General Service rate to any customer using the City's electric system for all requirements other than residential service where such customer has a monthly peak kilowatt demand of less than or equal to 25 kilowatts during the current or previous eighteen billing periods and 2500 kilowatt-hours or less in the current billing period. Any customer whose monthly peak demand has exceeded 25 kilowatts in the current or previous eighteen billing periods or has exceeded 2500 kilowatt-hours during the current billing period will be billed at the rate described in Section 13.08.260."

SECTION TWO: That after the adoption and approval hereof this Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.

SECTION THREE: That all ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, expressly repealed.

SECTION FOUR: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
