CITY TREASURER'S REPORT: Quarterly Financial Report: The Board reviewed the Quarterly Financial Report for the period ending April 30, 2024 prepared by the City of St. Charles. As of April 30, 2024, the net position held in trust for pension benefits is \$54,609,659.94. The Board also reviewed the Expenditure Approval List for the period March 1, 2024 through May 31, 2024 with expenditures totaling \$113,973.05. Discussion/Possible Action – Cash Management Policy: The Board discussed the current Cash Management Policy and determined no changes were necessary at this time.

INVESTMENT REPORTS: FPIF –Marquette Associates: The Board reviewed the FPIF Monthly Summary prepared by Marquette Associates for the period ending April 30, 2024. As of April 30, 2024, the one-month total net return is (2.9%) and the year-to-date total net return is 1.8% for an ending market value of \$8,547,524,492. The current asset allocation is as follows: Total Equity at 65.1%, Fixed Income at 29.8%, Real Estate at 4.4% and Cash 0.6%.

FPIF – Statement of Results: The Board reviewed the FPIF Statement of Results for the periods ending February 29, 2024, March 31, 2024 and April 30, 2024. As of April 30, 2024 the beginning value was \$55,652,401.55, the ending value was \$53,746,393.21, the net return on total assets was (2.95%) and the Fund's ownership in FPIF is 0.63%.

A motion was made by Trustee Swanson and seconded by Trustee Wilton to approve the regular retirement benefits effective July 22, 2024 for Brian Hansen pending receipt of the calculation from the City of St. Charles and verified by the Board.
