**Executive Summary** (if not budgeted please explain):

MR25, LLC has requested permission for a Main St. (IL Rt. 64) closure for a film production. This will take place Wednesday, October 16<sup>th</sup>, 2024. They have also requested a contingency date of Thursday, October 17<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Production will take place from 4pm to 5am on October 16th. In the event October 17<sup>th</sup> is needed, the same timeframe would apply.

The contingency closure is requested in the event of inclement weather or if the production team is unable to complete their planned filming in 1 day.

There are multiple other approvals that will be brought before city council for this production in the future. However, this approval will be needed immediately due to IDOT's application requirements. Please see the attached document of closure requests as well as anticipated cost from the Police Department and Public Works.

The production company is planning to work with the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) on requested road closures of Main Street between 2nd St. (IL Rt. 31) and 5<sup>th</sup> Ave (IL Rt. 25). This closure allows for north and southbound traffic on Rt. 31 and Rt. 25. The Police Department will staff various intersections throughout the closure as well as the detour route for pedestrian and traffic control. The sidewalks will remain accessible for pedestrians during the closure. Closures are subject to IDOT approval. Please see the attached document showing the Rt. 64 closure area and detour route requested

Public Works has advised that the signage and barricade request would be outsourced to a private company. Their estimate reflects the quote provided by the outside company.

The production company has no electric needs and will be providing their own generators.

Members of the production company will visit each business that may potentially be impacted by this production to inform them of the project. There are no requests to have any businesses closed during the filming.

The estimates above reflect the cost of a 1-day closure. Council members have asked MR25, LLC if they will reimburse the City for associated costs and they have confirmed this.

## A Resolution Requesting the Closure of Route 64 for a Movie Production

WHEREAS, MR25, LLC is producing portions of a movie in the City of St. Charles, and;

WHEREAS, this production will require the temporary closure of Main Street (Route 64) state highway in the City of St. Charles, and;

WHEREAS, Section 4-408 of the Illinois Highway Code authorizes the Department of Transportation to issue permits to local authorities to temporarily close portions of state highways for such public purposes or needs as parades and local celebrations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. Charles that permission to close Main Street (Route 64) between 2<sup>nd</sup> St. (Route 31) and 5<sup>th</sup> Ave. (Route 25) on Wednesday, October 16th, 2024 from 4pm to 5am. A rain date of Thursday October 17<sup>th</sup>, with the same timeframe is also requested of the Department of Transportation;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if such permission is granted by the Department of Transportation, all highway traffic during the periods of time specified shall be detoured over the following routes:


For westbound on Route 64: south on 5th Avenue (Route 25) to Illinois Avenue, west to 2<sup>nd</sup> St Street (Route 31), north on 2<sup>nd</sup> St. to return to westbound Route 64. For eastbound Route 64, use the reverse route.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if such permission is granted by the Department of Transportation, the City of St. Charles assumes full responsibility for the direction, protection and regulation of the traffic during the time the detour is in effect, and all liabilities for damages of any kind occasioned by the closing of the state highway, and it is further agreed that efficient all-weather detours will be maintained to the satisfaction of the Department and conspicuously marked for the benefit of traffic diverted from the state highway.
